Seeding Guidelines

PREPARE THE AREA

Break up the soil surface with a rake or spade using a crisscross pattern.

TOP DRESS

The area to be seeded should be top-dressed with clean, weed-free topsoil to a depth of one inch.

FERTILIZE

Use a high phosphorous fertilizer and blend it in with the topsoil according to the manufacturer's coverage rates.

SELECT THE GRASS SEED

Select from a variety of mixtures that are compatible with your chosen site. You will find a large selection of grass seeds at Bucks Country Gardens. Ask us for assistance in selecting the best choice for your needs.

SEED

Using our SEEDING RATES AND SPREADER SETTING GUIDELINES apply the grass seed and incorporate into the top 1/4-inch of the soil. SO NOT BURY THE SEED. Cover lightly with straw to retain moisture.

IRRIGATION

Water lightly on a daily basis (if there is no rainfall) until the seed begins to germinate. Cut the new grass when it reaches 3-inches in height and between 2-3 inches thereafter. Avoid foot traffic until the new lawn is cut twice.

We recommend seeding your lawn during late summer and fall. The cooler nights and warmer days are ideal growing conditions for establishing your lawn.
