## TOXIC

Buckeye

The following plants are considered toxic. Symptoms may vary from a mild stomachache, skin rash, swelling of the mouth and throat, to involvement of the heart, kidneys or other organs.

The Delaware Valley Poison Control (215) 386-2100 can give you more specific information on these or other plants that can be poisonous and may not be on this list. Many plants do not cause toxicity unless ingested in very large amounts.
