## Tree Fruit Varieties For Pennsylvania

Tree fruit varieties are all nearly equally useful, except the crabs and quinces, as fresh fruit or for home processing. They varieties are listed in order of ripening. Check our literature racks for complete descriptions of these fruits. It is doubtful that the peach, nectarine, and apricot varieties listed will do well in the colder areas of the state.
